Part-time Visiting Faculty Position BIO Program Spring Term 2010

The BIO Program at Centre College in Danville, KY invites applications for a part-time instructor position for the spring term of 2010.

Teaching responsibilities include:

- One upper level BIO elective (3 hours)
- One section (28 students) of an introductory BIO lab

For the upper level elective course, preference will be given to applicants who can teach entomology or an elective in an organismic or ecological field. The upper level elective course will be taught as a lecture only class that meets 3 hours per week. This lecture class could be scheduled to meet for three one hour time blocks or two 90 min time blocks each week. The upper level course will most likely have an enrollment of 10-15 students.

The introductory laboratory class is co-taught with another faculty member who will take care of all set-up and take-down of the lab. The lab meets in one three hour time block each week. The specific exercises and syllabus for the lab course have already been developed by the BIO faculty. This lab section will have a maximum enrollment of 28 students.

The Centre College 2010 spring term classes will meet from Feb 3 through May 11 and final exams are scheduled through May 19.

Qualifications: Successful applicant will either hold Ph.D. or will be near completion of a Ph.D in a biological discipline. Applicants should send a copy of their current vita and names of three references to:
